

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What level does my child need to be to apply for Program of Excellence (POE) – The Arts Production and Performance?

All students from Year 7-12 in 2025 are eligible to apply for the POE - The Arts at Albany Creek State High School. Acceptance to the program is based on the outcome of an audition to be held at the high school in the second week of June 2024 and receipt of further audition material submitted to the Department of Art, please see *How to submit Audition Online* instructions

- Dance Tuesday 4 June 2024, (XPAC at 3.30 pm to 4.45 pm)
- Instrumental Music Wednesday 5 June 2024, (Music Centre XPAC 3.30 pm to 4.45 pm)
- Visual Art Thursday 6 June 2024, (E Block Art Rooms 3.30 pm to 4.45 pm)
- Media Arts Friday 7 June 2024 submission of creative video

If my child is offered a place in more than one Program of Excellence - can they accept all offers?

No. Due to program commitments students can only be accepted into one of the five programs. Please note students may try out for The POE - The Arts and Football but can only accept a place in one program.

Are there fees for Program of Excellence - The Arts?

Yes. Students are charged a fee for the year to cover all artists in residence, workshops, consumable materials and costumes etc. The fees for The Arts POEs are outlined in the Albany Creek State High School Student Resource Hire Scheme.

What is the time commitment for students in Program of Excellence - The Arts?

Each program is unique in the delivery of workshops, classes and artists in residence programs. Students will be required to commit to before or after school rehearsals and Junior students must select Arts Excellence as an option for their Wednesday Afternoon Module (WAM) or Thursday Activity Module (TAM). Every student in a Program of Excellence - The Arts will attend a minimum of two lessons a week, lessons listed overleaf.

What do I wear in the audition for Dance or Instrumental Music?

Students are required to wear comfortable clothing for the audition. Students may wear their school uniform or dance leotard, shorts or tights or costume if appropriate.

Can I audition for Program of Excellence – Instrumental Music if I am not at the level recommended?

Yes. The level recommended for the POE – The Arts - Instrumental Music is Education Queensland Curriculum Level 4 and/or AMEB 2 or equivalent preferably EQ Curriculum Level 5 and/or AMEB 3 or equivalent. All students in the Program of Excellence must be in the Instrumental Music Program at Albany Creek State High School. POE – The Arts is an extension of the classroom and Instrumental Music Program at the school. If students are not accepted into the Program of Excellence, it does not impact their membership of the Instrumental Music Program.

Can I apply for Program of Excellence - Media Arts if I do not have media experience?

Yes. The Program of Excellence is an extension of the classroom Media Arts Program at the school. If students are not accepted into the Program of Excellence, it does not impact their ability to continue with Media Arts in the curriculum.

If my child is not accepted into the Program of Excellence - The Arts, can they be involved in any others Arts curriculum?

Yes. There are many opportunities at Albany Creek State High School to be involved in learning in The Arts. Our students can study Dance, Music, Instrumental Music and Visual Art from Years 7 to 12. They can be involved in performances such as Dance Showcase, Music Night and Wednesday Afternoon Module (WAM) and Thursday Activity Module (TAM) Arts activities during school hours.

If your child is not accepted into an excellence program in the Arts. There are many extra curricula offerings at the school such as:

- Dance Performance team as an extension to WAM and TAM Dance.
- AC Voices at lunchtime an extension to instrumental and classroom music.
- Lunchtime activities in Visual Art.

Student Contract

Students and parents/carers are required to sign a *Student Commitment Contract*, which upholds behavioural expectations.

Failure to uphold expectations can result in removal from the Program of Excellence.
