OVERVIEW

Albany Creek State High School values Music in education as an intellectually engaging intersection of lateral thought and practice. Music is a unique art form that uses sound and silence as a means of personal expression and occupies a significant place in their everyday life of all cultures and societies, serving social, cultural, celebratory, political and educational roles.

The Program of Excellence Music combines the development of cognitive, psychomotor and affective domains through elite performance. Students are provided with a unique opportunity to come together with like minded, talented musicians for a 70 minute ensemble conducted by a professional senior teacher before school and for Year 7 and 8 a small group lesson during Wednesday afternoon modules and Year 9 and 10 during Thursday activity modules.

Students in the Program of Excellence Music also participate in the Instrumental Program, classroom music and are invited to be in the Music Extension Program in Year 12 for Performance or Composition.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERA

Students applying for the Program of Excellence Music need to:

- Be able to read music notation fluently and demonstrate talent, skills and commitment to music.
- Undertake an audition demonstrating two contrasting pieces chosen in consultation with their instrumental music teacher.

To maintain a position in the Program of Excellence Music students must satisfy the following criteria:

- must satisfy the following criteria:Attend regular scheduled Instrumental Music lessons at school.
- Be undertaking a core Music elective program across years 7-12 and set an exemplary standard of effort and behaviour both in class and scheduled Excellence classes.
- · Achieve a B or higher in core curriculum Music study.
- · Maintain a minimum C standard in English.
- Maintain satisfactory standards in classroom effort and behaviour across all subject areas.

GOALS OF THE PROGRAM

- To Improve the quality of perception and self-expression of students by fostering the acquisition of musical skills, thereby increasing aesthetic sensibility, cultural awareness and social-emotional engagement. Through the lens of music, students are empowered to make sense of their world and belong to a successful, high quality school program where they will develop skills, teamwork and create lifelong friendships.
- The overarching goal is to enrich students' lives with lifelong skills, perspectives and understandings, enhancing their ability to play music and perform in an elite music ensemble.
